

2006 IN REVIEW

FTH has conducted projects all over the world in the past 12 months. The projects we have completed are a testament to your compassion and generosity to a world in need. Time and time again, you exceeded our hopes and our expectations.

FTH's goal to bring relief is a representation of God's answer to the prayer "*Give us today our daily bread*". FTH has brought relief to people suffering the long-term effects of droughts and war; to children who without the orphanages we support, would be living homeless on the streets; and FTH has been able to bring relief to survivors of deadly natural disasters such as the earthquakes in Indonesia, typhoons in Philippines, and the escalation of military conflict between Israel and Hezbollah.

FTH was able to respond immediately to these natural disasters because of the regular giving by our partners. Thank you partners and friends for your faithful support.

Sending Hope to Darfur Sudan

Since October 2006, FTH has been providing regular food drops to Darfur, feeding over 1500 families. The most recent food drop included 30 tonnes of sorghum, 18 tonnes of lentils and 2 tonnes of cooking oil. FTH sent five shipping containers holding 1.3 million meals and will distributed in January 2007.



Disaster Relief - Indonesia

Over the 2004/2005 Christmas break, Indonesia seemed to bear the brunt of a natural disaster that affected the entire world. A terrifying tsunami killed over 300,000 people and just 18 short months later, Indonesia cried again as two more natural disasters claimed the lives of another 6000 people.

FTH was quick to respond to the situation sending emergency funds to feed families forgotten by the government and the other aid agencies. Our Indonesian partner on the ground was so relieved to hear that we were sending funds to buy food. She was already preparing supplies to send, but realized she had no food only blankets and clothing from her warehouse. It was literally just a few minutes later after she realized her lack, that FTH called to fill that need.

The relief operations consisted of four separate teams—advance, medical, pastors and prayer teams. The inclusion of prayer teams really struck me as being most apt. They would provide practical relief as possible, but more importantly they would intercede in the heavenly realms.

We know that God heard the cries and anguish of the Indonesian people, but how much more effective were the prayers of God's covenant people in this earth—who stepped into the gap and helped lift the burden at that critical time?

I really want to thank our partners and friends who not only gave generously to this disaster but heeded our urging, and took the time to intercede for the Indonesian people.



Disaster Relief - Israel

As the tension between Israel and Hezbollah developed into full-scale military conflict, FTH was there helping to feed families stranded in makeshift bomb shelters with nowhere else to go.

"I am so grateful for your supporting love even though you don't know me personally. You refreshed my spirit in the hardest time of my life. Had you not stood with us here in Acco, doors would not have opened for us.

I don't know how to thank you and the ministry of Feed The Hungry. I can tell you are all doing a holy job that continues to warm God's heart...

We were able to be a light to Israel during these trying days. We were involved in many ways of helping... Our congregation has stood the test of war and thanks to you, we have been able to offer support to the city in this time of distress."

Four Nation Appeal

This appeal aimed at providing relief to African nations suffering long-term disasters such as famine and drought, was launched in May. Containers of a dehydrated soup mix combining rice, soy, vegetables, vitamins and minerals packaged in small durable pouches were donated to FTH.

Because of your generous response, FTH was able to expand the project from the original five partners to a total of seven partner organisations throughout Kenya, Malawi, Niger, Swaziland & Mozambique.



FTH sent 1.925 million meals to Africa as part of this appeal.

Project Cambodia

FTH provided funds to ship four containers of rice donated to the Four Square Ministry orphanage in Cambodia run by Ted Olbrich. The "Children of Promise" orphanage takes care of 4000 children throughout Cambodia.

"Thank you for partnering with us. We so appreciate and are honoured by your help. All four containers arrived safely. Two five-ton trucks are moving rice and a fortified dried soup mix out to the 84 orphanage locations."

Ethiopia - Massive Food Distribution

Ethiopia was the destination of FTH's major food project for 2006. Combining the resources of all international offices, FTH distributed 350,000kg of food, bibles and Gospel literature to 10,000 of the neediest families in the Awasa region.

Tens of thousands of people heard the gospel over six nights under the ministry of Ps. Billy-Jo & Sharon Daugherty. Each night hundreds of people surged to the stage in response to the altar call. Dozens of people testified each night with great joy, the miraculous healing power of God as they were prayed for.

A small church was crammed to capacity each morning with almost two thousand pastors and leaders, travelling from all over Ethiopia to

participate. Ps. Billy-Jo and members of his ministry team spoke about increasing their effectiveness in reaching their neighbours, and relying on the Holy Ghost for inspiration and motivation. Each leader was provided handouts and taught simple leadership concepts to boost their effectiveness and maintain their motivation.

Working with pastors from local Awasa churches, two warehouses were selected and began to receive the vital food. As part of the essential Ethiopian diet, FTH purchased 20kg of corn, 10kg of wheat, 5kg beans and included a bible and gospel literature in their own language for each of the 10,000 food packs.

Feeding EveryChild EveryDay

2006 saw the continued growth of FTH's new orphanage support initiative we call "EveryChild EveryDay". FTH reaches out to established Christian orphanages around the world to bring relief to the daily burden of the budget for food.

By supplementing the orphanage's budget, we allow them to improve the quality of life for their children with their existing funding, and in most cases it enables them to expand their intake.

Some orphanages have been receiving the dehydrated soup mix, that has been generously donated by Feed My Starving Children. All around the world they are telling us the same thing:

"the kids are starting to look better... you can see it on their skins... thank God for this food... we can tell they are nutritionally charged & making a visible difference... in only a short period of time!"

Many orphanages already report that their children return to their facility to serve as

teachers, cooks, grounds keepers and in any other capacity they can find once they graduate from the school.
