SUDAN UPDATE

Just as you were receiving the August partner letter, the situation in Sudan was rapidly unravelling into a dangerous civil unrest with the death of the Sudanese Vice-President. Jean-Pierre Rummens, our man in the field, was uncomfortably close to the trouble and was forced to relocate hotels and eventually evacuate out of the country once the U.N. security forces admitted they could not guarantee his safety or evacuation if the situation worsened.

Jean-Pierre has safely returned home and along with other members of our logistics team are preparing to return to Sudan. The team will re-assess the viability and timetable of our project which we are still planing to accomplish in October and November 2005, now that the situation has once again stabilised.

Islamic radicals are already there in Sudan, and have purposed themselves to win Sudan at any cost and by any means available. This unstable and uneasy environment plays right into the devil's hands and will hinder the sharing of the Gospel. Join us in prayer for the situation to remain calm, and that the roads will stay open for our projects in Sudan.

ETHIOPIA FEBRUARY 2006

Feed The Hungry is in the early stages of preparing for a large project in Ethiopia in February 2006. To get an idea of how large a project, consider this – we regularly send approx. 140,000kg of food out to each project – that's roughly 6 semi-trailers of food and aid.

Our three-fold vision of *feeding the hungry, encouraging pastors and evangelising the lost*, enables us to use this food to great affect for the nation. In Rwanda last year those 6 semi-trailers were the cornerstone of an evangelical crusade that brought 15,000 people into the kingdom. In the Dominican Republic earlier this year, we counted 66,000 salvations. In Liberia we have 58,745 recorded re-dedications and 59,977 recorded salvations.

We want to send 1.4million kilograms of food and aid to Ethiopia in February 2006. We are expecting to have a greater impact on the nation then we've ever seen before. If we can create an atmosphere where over 100,000 people give their heart to Jesus, then our heart's bursting with expectation at the impact we can have with 60 semi-trailers of food!

It's our goal. As partners and friends, please join us in asking God for seed to sow, in accordance with the same biblical promises that say God wants us to prosper so that we can abound to *every good work!* (2 Corinthians, Chapter 9).
