**UPDATE: SUDAN – DARFUR REGION**

FTH is continuing to raise funds to send five containers of food to Sudan to be distributed in early January 2007. To meet the current needs, we have already begun a monthly food-drop to 9000 people, through the Safe Harbour Team (our ministry partners). This is approximately 25 tonnes of food and is being distributed to those people identified as the most vulnerable - those from make-shift camps consisting mainly of widows and their children. FTH aims to continue making these monthly food drops until our 5 containers arrive in January. Your continued support will ensure the uninterrupted supply of these food-drops, until our containers arrive in January.

**TESTIMONY: ISRAEL RELIEF**

As Hezbollah rockets begin falling into Northern Israel, FTH was in contact with Pastor Guy Cohen. He is the pastor of Katzir Asher congregation in the city of Acco, just 12 miles from the Lebanon border. Acco had been struck with 200 of the 900 Ketusha rockets that landed in populated areas. One of these Ketusha rockets hit the car in the picture below – a car Ps. Cohen had past just 10sec before.

FTH sent an emergency fund transfer for the purchase of food and supplies to help hundreds of families who had no choice but to remain in the city and live in bomb shelters for weeks. Pastor Guy was able to purchase: milk, sugar, canned tuna, flour, cooking oil, cookies, rice, instant coffee, and canned corn, beans, and peas. Food boxes were prepared and distributed among people stuck in shelters; hot meals were given to the elderly each day at lunch time; and Shabbot boxes for the families in shelters were handed out on Friday's.
